This contract is to be completed by any person (the applicant) applying to take wedding photographs or film footage within the Te Uru building.

Please note: fees apply to wedding photography or filming. Fees are required to be paid prior to the date of photography/filming.

FILMING/ PHOTOGRAPHY CONDITIONS:

- Works of art may not be touched or moved.
- Any artworks covered by copyright will not be allowed to be filmed or photographed. A gallery representative will advise you on these artworks.
- A maximum of two light sources are to be used, unless authorised by the gallery. Lights must not shine directly onto an artwork and are to be shut off except when actual photography is taking place.
- All light stands or similar equipment are to be placed a minimum of 1.5 metres away from any artwork. All equipment on stands must be placed at a distance that is greater than their height away from any artwork.
- All cables are to be positioned so as to not constitute a tripping or other hazard.
- There is no consumption of food or drink allowed in the gallery spaces.
- No chemicals or hairsprays are to be used in the galleries.
- If any extraordinary costs are incurred by filming or photography in the galleries, these costs will be on-charged.
- For insurance purposes, gallery staff will be required to oversee the photography or filming where lighting tripods or other equipment is used.
- The gallery reserves the right to change any arrangement if our representative believes that works of art are being put at risk.

Please note that permission may need to be sought from artist(s) if artworks are going to be included in the photography or filming.

HEALTH & SAFETY CONDITIONS:

In order to follow best safety practices, compliance with the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 must be followed at all times.

I am responsible for any damage caused and my own (and that of members of my group) Health & Safety.

I agree to observe all directions from the gallery representative relating to Health & Safety, the security of the site, and the property of Te Uru.
